1. AGP appreciates the patience of the Commission as this matter has taken longer to conclude than was originally anticipated.

A major part of the delay has been engendered by the parties mutual desire to accommodate or address in the settlement document the appropriate handling of changes in environmental modifications that were made or planned to be made at the Lake Road Plant. The passage of time has eliminated the need to address these changes in the settlement document.
