In March 2008, MDNR issued to Ameren Missouri a permit to construct a utility waste landfill (UWL) located at the Sioux Power Plant. The UWL manages disposal material from the flue gas desulfurization system ("FGD" or "scrubber") and coal combustion waste. Operation of the UWL commenced in late 2010 following MDNR issuance of an Operating Permit in July 2010 and St. Charles County's issuance of a Solid Waste Facility license in November of that year. In April of 2011, Ameren Missouri submitted a permit modification to begin the construction of a dry cell, and MDNR issued its approval in February 2013. Construction of the dry cell should begin the summer of 2013.

No Letters of Warning or Notices of Violation have been issued by MDNR concerning the operation of the Sioux Utility Waste landfill.
