I am replying to your letter of March 16, 2010, regarding the interconnection agreement between Global Crossing Local Services, Inc. and Global Crossing Telemanagement, Inc. ("Global Crossing") and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company ("AT&T-Missouri").

In accordance with your request, Global Crossing hereby provides notice, pursuant to section 252(a)(1) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, that it wishes to negotiate a successor interconnection agreement. Global Crossing proposes that negotiations commence upon AT&T's receipt of this letter as evidenced by receipt from the overnight delivery service that delivers this notice.

Global Crossing is interested, in the context of such negotiations, to explore the possibility of porting, for the State of Missouri, the Global Crossing-BellSouth agreement currently in effect.
