1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 (WHEREUPON, the hearing began at  
3 8:31 a.m.)

4 JUDGE JORDAN: The Commission is  
5 calling the action in File No. ER-2016-0156. This  
6 is in the matter of KCP&L Greater Missouri  
7 Operations Company's request for authority to  
8 implement a general rate increase for electric  
9 service.

10 I'm Daniel Jordan. I'm the  
11 Regulatory Law Judge assigned to this action.  
12 We'll begin by taking entries of appearance. For  
13 KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations.

14 MR. FISCHER: Thank you, Judge. On  
15 behalf of the company, let the record reflect the  
16 appearance of Robert J. Hack, Roger W. Steiner and  
17 James M. Fischer. Our information has been  
18 provided to the court reporter.

19 JUDGE JORDAN: Thank you. And for  
20 the Commission Staff.

21 MR. WILLIAMS: Nathan Williams.

22 JUDGE JORDAN: Thank you. For the  
23 Office of the Public Counsel.

24 MS. MAYFIELD: Good morning, your  
25 Honor. Cydney Mayfield, and my information has

1 also been previously provided to our court  
2 reporter.

3 JUDGE JORDAN: Thank you. And is  
4 there anyone else here to put in an entry of  
5 appearance? I see the Division of Energy is  
6 present.

7 MR. ANTAL: Yes. Thank you, your  
8 Honor. Thank you, Commissioners. Alex Antal with  
9 the Missouri Division of Energy.

10 JUDGE JORDAN: Thank you. And I  
11 think that's everyone appearing this morning; is  
12 that correct? Not hearing anyone.

13 We have some preliminary matters, and  
14 I think that's all we have today. Parties, as I  
15 understand it, are not planning to present evidence  
16 or argument today; is that correct?

17 MR. HACK: That is correct, Judge.  
18 Rob Hack with KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations  
19 Company. We circulated a comprehensive settlement  
20 document among the parties last evening. We --  
21 there are a couple of what I would call loose ends  
22 regarding kind of tying down agreement in principle  
23 on a couple of matters.

24 What our plan would be, assuming that  
25 it meets with the approval of you and the

1 Commission, would be to commit as much as we can  
2 for the future to make -- to make this stipulation  
3 filing by Tuesday of next week. And there's no  
4 hearing scheduled for Wednesday because of FRI, but  
5 Thursday and Friday are still, as I understand it,  
6 committed to this proceeding hearing-wise.

7           So the parties, if the Commission  
8 would be inclined to want to have an on-the-record  
9 presentation next week, would offer those days as  
10 possible days to do that. Obviously it's up to  
11 what the Commission wants to do schedule-wise and  
12 whether they want to have a presentation or not.

13           What I would tell you is that the  
14 terms of the agreement contemplated right now do  
15 not call for expedited implementation of the  
16 tariffs earlier than the current or substantially  
17 earlier than the current effective date in late  
18 December.

19           But there is a fair bit of  
20 implementation work associated with the rate  
21 district consolidation, kind of behind-the-scenes  
22 work that would -- it would be helpful for the  
23 parties to know sooner rather than later, not  
24 immediately, that the Commission did find the  
25 agreement acceptable. So that would be helpful.

1 We're not trying to put pressure on the Commission  
2 by any means. Just trying to be full disclosure  
3 here.

4 JUDGE JORDAN: You're correct that we  
5 have all the weekdays next week except Wednesday  
6 reserved for this proceeding. Does anyone want to  
7 add anything else as to your progress?

8 MR. WILLIAMS: Don't have anything to  
9 add, but I'll state that Staff concurs in what  
10 KCPL -- or what KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations  
11 Company has described.

12 JUDGE JORDAN: Okay.

13 MS. MAYFIELD: I guess I'll follow  
14 along with Nathan just to throw it out there, but  
15 OPC concurs with what Greater Missouri Operations  
16 has described as well.

17 JUDGE JORDAN: Any inquiries from the  
18 Commissioners?

19 COMMISSIONER STOLL: Yes. Thank you,  
20 Judge. I think for the entire Commission I wanted  
21 to ask, is any part of the agreement black box  
22 settlement?

23 MR. HACK: Yes, your Honor.

24 COMMISSIONER STOLL: Okay. Could you  
25 say what part that is? Would you prefer to wait?

1 MR. HACK: Well, it will be clear  
2 from the document next Tuesday. We have attempted  
3 to honor the Commission's wishes as expressed in  
4 the Empire proceeding, so we did lay out a range of  
5 ROE in our document.

6 COMMISSIONER STOLL: Got you. Okay.

7 MR. HACK: But as you may imagine,  
8 there's quite a difference of opinions among the  
9 parties on a variety of revenue requirement issues,  
10 so the lion's share of those are just part of a  
11 black box.

12 COMMISSIONER STOLL: Okay. We've  
13 kind of -- we've talked a little bit about having  
14 an on-the-record next week with the judge, and if  
15 things worked out right, we were thinking or the  
16 two of us were thinking Thursday afternoon because  
17 we've got FRI Wednesday, we have agenda Thursday  
18 morning.

19 But if we get the information between  
20 ourselves and we've prepared for the case already,  
21 then looking that over and having our advisors do  
22 that, I think we should be ready then. But the  
23 judge will poll the other Commissioners regarding  
24 that.

25 MR. HACK: That would be excellent

1 because we're -- we're ready, too, and we have  
2 people freed up given the other scheduled  
3 activities.

4 COMMISSIONER STOLL: Okay. Thank  
5 you.

6 JUDGE JORDAN: Anything else from the  
7 Commission? I have nothing for you. Here's what  
8 I -- here's what I -- oh, Division of Energy had a  
9 comment earlier.

10 MR. ANTAL: Judge, I was just going  
11 to concur with the other parties that we believe  
12 this time frame to file the stip and on the record  
13 is reasonable to us, too.

14 JUDGE JORDAN: Very good. Thank you.  
15 Here's what I plan to do, then. I will put out an  
16 order suspending the hearing as to presentation of  
17 evidence and argument for the remaining dates, not  
18 canceling them, but holding them so that we can  
19 have this time, the time reserved for an  
20 on-the-record presentation.

21 And for anyone unfamiliar with  
22 Commission procedure, on-the-record presentation is  
23 basically kind of an enhanced oral argument, an  
24 oral presentation with witnesses handy to give  
25 testimony as needed.



1 MR. FISCHER: Judge, we haven't  
2 identified our exhibits. Should we plan on doing  
3 that at the on the record or should we just  
4 stipulate that into the record? Do you have a  
5 preference?

6 JUDGE JORDAN: Stipulating the entry  
7 of exhibits into the record, that can be done in  
8 writing, and that would be perfectly fine. I have  
9 seen that done in stipulations and agreements in  
10 the past where items are specified, listed, and  
11 then all parties agree that they shall be entered  
12 into the record and then the Commission can make  
13 its decision based on that evidence, and that seems  
14 to work smoothly.

15 Anything else I can do for you before  
16 we go off the record?

17 MR. HACK: We would simply say thank  
18 you for providing us the time to get the case  
19 settled. We know that there's been a lot of  
20 uncertainty, and we regret causing any unnecessary  
21 preparation, but we appreciate the time to get the  
22 case settled.

23 COMMISSIONER STOLL: I might comment,  
24 thank you for that. That is why we're here. We  
25 are always ready to go when we need to be, and we

1 appreciate the hard work, obviously the hard work  
2 that all the parties put into it to get to this  
3 settlement. So thank you, too.

4 JUDGE JORDAN: Anything else before  
5 we go off the record then? Not hearing anything,  
6 we'll adjourn this hearing and we will go off the  
7 record.
