1 JUDGE DIPPELL: Good afternoon. This is July
2 10th, 2018, and the Missouri Public Service Commission has set a
3 time for a local public hearing in File Nos. ER-2018-0145 and
4 ER-2018-0146 in which Kansas City Power and Light Company and
5 KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's have requested to
6 implement a general rate increase.

7 My name is Nancy Dippell. I'm a regulatory law
8 judge that will preside over this hearing and I have with me
9 Chairman Hall from the Public Service Commission. We will begin
10 with letting counsel for the Company and Staff and Public
11 Counsel make their entries of appearance. I'll start with the
12 Company, KCPL?

13 MR. HACK: Good afternoon. Robert Hack, H-A-C-K
14 for Kansas City Power and Light Company and KCPL Greater
15 Missouri Operations Company. Thank you.

16 JUDGE DIPPELL: Commission staff?

17 MR. IRVING: Good afternoon. Ron Irving, staff
18 counsel. I believe the court reporter has my information.

19 JUDGE DIPPELL: Thank you.

20 Office of Public Counsel?

21 MR. SMITH: Thank you, Judge. For OPC, Ryan
22 Smith and my information has been provided.

23 JUDGE DIPPELL: Are there any interveners that

2 This is your opportunity to make on-the-record comments. You

5 chairman and other commissioners who will read the transcript,
6 which the court reporter is transcribing. If you would like to
7 give public comments, I'll ask you to come up to the podium and
8 I will ask you to swear or affirm to tell the truth and then you
9 can give your comments on the record. Like I say, these
10 comments do become part of the official record and the other
11 commissioners will review them in the transcript from the
12 proceeding.

13 With that, I didn't have anyone signed up on the
14 signup list, but would anyone like to testify? No comments?
15 Well, I appreciate you coming in and hearing what the staff had
16 to say and what the company and the Office of Public Counsel had
17 to say. If you have any other questions, please feel free to
18 take advantage of the resources up here. If you know of anyone
19 who wanted to be here, but couldn't, please tell them to go to
20 our website and make their comments known or contact the Office
21 of Public Counsel and make comments known.

22 So with that, if there's nothing else we can go
23 ahead and conclude the hearing and go off the record.
