ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

On April 5, 2007, Kansas City Power & Light Company filed tariff sheets with an effective date of May 5, 2007, designed to make changes to its MPower program. The program is the result of a Stipulation and Agreement reached in KCPL's Regulatory Plan, Case No. EO-2005-0329. On April 11, 2007, the Commission issued notice of the revised tariff sheets and set an intervention deadline.

Praxair, Inc., filed a timely application to intervene. Praxair relates that it was a party to Case No. EO-2005-0329, and that it is a large industrial customer of KCPL receiving service on an interruptible basis under a separate contract and rate schedule. Praxair states that because of its status as a major interruptible customer, Praxair's interest in this case is direct, immediate, different from that of the general public, and will not or cannot adequately be represented by any other party. For purposes of 4 CSR 240-2.075(2), Praxair states that it opposes discriminatory and non-cost-based pricing of electricity and related utility services. No response has been filed to Praxair's application to intervene and the deadline for doing so has passed.

The Commission has reviewed Praxair's pleading and finds it to be in substantial compliance with 4 CSR 240-2.075. Praxair's application to intervene will therefore be granted.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Praxair, Inc.'s application to intervene is granted and Praxair is made a party to this case.
2. This order shall become effective on April 23, 2007.
