ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

The Commission established this case to consider revisions to Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE's Industrial Demand Response Tariff. Anheuser-Busch Companies, Inc.; BioKyowa, Inc.; The Boeing Company; DaimlerChrysler; Doe Run; Enbridge, Inc.; Explorer Pipeline Company; GKN Aerospace; General Motors Corporation; Hussmann Corporation; JW Aluminum; Monsanto; Pfizer; Precoat Metals; Proctor & Gamble Company; Nestlé Purina PetCare; Solutia; and U.S. Silica Company, collectively known as Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC), filed an application to intervene on July 11, 2007. More than ten days have passed since the application to intervene was filed and no party has objected to it.

The Commission finds that MIEC has an interest that is different from that of the general public and that its interest may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing MIEC to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Application to Intervene of Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers is granted.
2. This order shall become effective on July 24, 2007.
