ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE EXPEDITED RECOMMENDATION

On October 26, 2007, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, filed a revised tariff that would provide a financial rebate to customers who choose to install a safe connection system for backup electric generation equipment. AmerenUE initially filed this revised tariff on October 2, with a November 2 effective date. However, the company withdrew that tariff to make modifications requested by the Commission's Staff and the Office of the Public Counsel. AmerenUE asks that the newly modified tariff be allowed to go into effect on the originally planned November 2 effective date. The motion represents that neither Staff, nor Public Counsel, object to the motion or the tariff.

Given the apparent agreement that expedited consideration of the tariff is appropriate, the Commission will direct its Staff to file its recommendation regarding the tariff in an expedited manner.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Commission's Staff shall file its recommendation regarding Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE's tariff no later than 1:00 p.m. on October 31, 2007.

2. This order shall become effective on October 29, 2007.
