## ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME IN WHICH TO RESPOND TO MOTION FOR IMMEDIATE INTERIM RELIEF

Issue Date: January 9, 2007 Effective Date: January 9, 2007

On January 8, 2007, USW Local 11-6 filed a motion to asking the Commission for immediate interim relief pursuant to section 386.310.1, RSMo 2000. The motion describes two new gas leak incidents and asks the Commission to order Laclede Gas Company to immediately begin inspecting every gas meter that is equipped with an AMR device at the rate of 80,000 meters per month.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) provides that parties are allowed not more than ten days to respond to a motion unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. Because the Union's motion alleges the need for expedited action, the Commission will shorten the time for response to the motion.

- 1. Any party wishing to respond to USW Local 11-6's Motion for Immediate Interim Relief shall do so no later than January 16, 2007.
