ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME IN WHICH TO RESPOND TO STAFF'S
MOTION TO RELEASE PUBLIC INFORMATION

On October 27, 2006, the Commission's Staff filed a motion asking the Commission to order Missouri Pipeline Company and Missouri Gas Company to review the direct testimony of Staff's witness, Robert Schallenberg, to determine what portion of that testimony and the attached exhibits can be reclassified as public rather than highly confidential. Staff asks that Missouri Pipeline and Missouri Gas be ordered to complete that review by November 8, or face reclassification of all of Schallenberg's testimony as public on November 10.

Before determining whether to grant the relief that Staff seeks, the Commission will give the other parties an opportunity to respond.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Any party that wants to respond to Staff's Motion to Release Public Information shall do so no later than November 2, 2006.
2. This order shall become effective on October 31, 2006.
