ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME FOR RESPONSE TO STAFF'S MOTION
TO COMPEL

On August 28, 2006, the Commission's Staff filed a motion asking the Commission to compel the Respondents – Missouri Pipeline Company, LLC, and Missouri Gas Company, LLC – to respond to a certain data request submitted to those companies by Staff. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) provides that parties are allowed not more than ten days to respond to a pleading, unless the Commission orders otherwise. Because Staff and the Respondents have previously discussed this discovery dispute and the Respondents are already familiar with Staff's assertions, the Commission will shorten the time for the Respondents, and any other interested party, to respond to Staff's motion.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Any party that wishes to respond to Staff's Motion to Compel Response to Discovery Request shall do so no later than September 1, 2006.
2. This order shall become effective on August 29, 2006.
