On June 29, 2006, Lynne P. Shewmaker filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission. Ms. Shewmaker claims that the new AMR meter that Laclede Gas Company installed for her is not properly calibrated, thereby resulting in Laclede overbilling her.
