PROPOSED LOCAL PUBLIC HEARINGS

COMES NOW the Office of Public Counsel ("Public Counsel") and, on behalf of itself, Consumers Council of Missouri, and Sierra Club, proposes the following regarding local public hearings in this case:

- 1. Public Counsel, Ameren Missouri, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, Consumers Council of Missouri, and Sierra Club have discussed their views of the appropriate ways for the Commission to hold local public hearings and where they should be held. They did not reach consensus on the number of local public hearings to recommend that the Commission hold.
- 2. Because of the extent of Ameren Missouri's service area and the socio-economic status of many whom it serves, Public Counsel, Consumers Council of Missouri, and Sierra Club recommend that the Commission hold at least eight live local public hearings—three in St. Louis County, one in St. Louis City, one in Kirksville, one in Kearney or Kingston, one in Cape Girardeau, and one in Jefferson City—and at least two virtual hearings. They agree that the following locations are reasonable venues for where the Commission holds the live hearings:
