7	A. My name is Kenneth Christie and my business address is Missouri		
8	Public Service Commission, P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102.		
9	Q. What is your present position with the Missouri Public Service		
10	Commission?		
11	A. I am a Regulatory Economist in the Economic Analysis Department of		
12	the Policy and Planning Division.		
13	Q. Are you the same Kenneth Christie that previously presented direct		
14	testimony in this case on February 13, 1997?		
15	A. Yes, I am.		
16	Q. What is the purpose of this direct testimony?		
17	A. The purpose of this testimony is to sponsor part of the class level		
18	adjusted hourly Missouri normal loads that are used to determine allocators for the		
19	Staff's class cost-of-service (COS) study performed in this case.		
20	Q. What classes did you adjust hourly loads for the COS studies?		
21	A. I adjusted hourly loads for the test year for the Residential		
22	Regular (rate 41), Residential Water Heating (rate 43), Residential Total Electric		
23	(rate 45), Feed Mills (rate 67), General Power - Secondary Voltage and General Power -		
24	Primary Voltage (rate 68) and Large Power (rate 77) rate classes.

1	Q. How are hourly loads adjusted?			
2	A. Please refer to the direct testimony of Staff witness Lena M. Mantle			
3	for a brief description of the adjustment process. This testimony refers to weather			
4	sensitive and non-weather sensitive classes. The weather sensitive classes I adjusted			
5	would be the three residential classes as well as the General Power - Secondary class.			
6	The remaining classes were considered non-weather sensitive.			
7	Q. Were your results checked for reasonableness?			
8	A. Yes, they were. Input data is thoroughly screened before the			
9	process is begun. Numerous checks and balances exist within the process to assure the			
10	validity of the calculations.			
11	Q. Which Staff witness used these hourly adjusted loads?			
12	A. The data was passed on to Staff witness Danial I. Beck for the			
13	purpose of applying hourly losses to the loads.			
14	Q. Does this conclude your direct testimony?			
15	A. Yes, it does.
