JUDGE DIPPELL: We can go ahead and go on the record. First I'd like to ask everybody who's not speaking at the moment, go ahead and mute yourself; that'll cut down on any noise, feedback, so forth.

Today is October 4, 2021. The Missouri Public Service Commission has set this time for a virtual local public hearing to give members of the public a chance to comment about Ameren Missouri's application in commission File No. GR-2021-0241 which is captioned as In the Matter of Union Electric Company doing business as Ameren Missouri's Tariff to Adjust its Revenues for Natural Gas Service.

The Missouri Public Service Commission regulates the rates and services of investor-owned utility companies in Missouri to ensure those rates and services are just and reasonable. The Commission also regulates the quality of service and safety operations of public utilities. The Commission is made up of five commissioners. The commissioners are appointed by the governor to fixed terms and confirmed by the Missouri Senate. The Commission employs staff of engineers, accountants, attorneys, financial analysts, and other specialists in the

field of utility regulations.

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My name is Nancy Dippell, and I'm the regulatory law judge assigned to this matter or this hearing. And with me online today are Commissioner Coleman and Commissioner Kolkmeyer. This is an official hearing of the Missouri Public Service Commission and the statement and testimony of witnesses will be recorded by the court reporter and must be given under oath or affirmation. The Commission has not made any decisions in this case and neither the commissioners nor myself can answer any questions today because the Commission must remain neutral until all the evidence is presented.

Commissioner Coleman or Commissioner
Kolkmeyer, did you have any opening statements you'd
like to make?

COMMISSIONER COLEMAN: I would just like to thank those that are in attendance for their participation tonight. As commissioners we take seriously what the public brings to us in these hearings, and we look forward to being able to gather the information. It will also of course be provided to the three commissioners not joining us tonight and used at the time that a decision must be made. Thank you again for your participation. Thank you, Judge.

    have anyone from Office of Public Counsel?
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MR. POSTON: Yes. Marc Poston appearing for the Office of the Public Counsel.

JUDGE DIPPELL: Thank you. Are there any attorneys for any of the intervenors that would like to make an entry? Call-in user, is there any attorney that wants to make an entry that didn't get an opportunity to?

All right. The process is basically going to be, since I didn't have anyone preregistered to testify tonight, the process is going to be that I'm just going to open it up to the floor and take you one at a time as best I can. If you would like to testify, I would just ask you to unmute yourself in just a minute when I ask and speak up and I'll -- like I say, I'll try to get you one at a time as I can.

When you are going to testify, I'll ask you to swear or affirm to tell the truth and I will ask you to state your name and to spell it and then you can give the commission your comments. After you've given your remarks, if you would stay on the line briefly so that in case I or the commissioners or some of the attorneys for the parties have some clarifying questions, we can ask those of you.

If you are just called in and not on your

computer or through the Webex link, you'll need to 1 2 both make sure you unmute your phone and also you may 3 have to press Star 6 to unmute yourself so that you 4 can be heard. 5 So at this time I'll go ahead then and 6 ask if there's anyone that would like to give us testimony tonight. If you need to press Star 6 if 7 8 you're a call-in user and that should unmute you. 9 Not hearing anyone, but I don't -- we had some problems earlier on a different case with a user who 10 11 had difficulty unmuting themselves, so I want to make 12 sure that we have plenty of opportunity. If you are 13 on a -- just calling in, you will have to press Star 14 and 6 to unmute. 15 Still not hearing anyone, Ms. Quick, did you have anyone asking questions during the question 16 17 and answer session? She may not be able to get unmuted either. 18 19 MS. KLIETHERMES: This is 20 Ms. Kliethermes. We did not have anyone. 21 JUDGE DIPPELL: We have several callers. 22 I know there are some staff members and Office of 23 Public Counsel and some company service people on the 24 line, so I'm going to do the last call then for people who would like to testify. If you are on the

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line and you didn't testify but you change your mind 1 2 later and want to, there is another hearing in the gas case. I'm going to apologize; I don't have the 3 4 date in front of me, but you can go to the commission webpage at psc.mo.gov. That's psc.mo.gov. And you 5 6 can also give written comments by going to that 7 webpage. And we ask that you reference the case number for this case which is GR-2021-0241. 8 9 If there is no one else, no one that 10 wants to speak up, I'm not seeing any phones 11 unmuting. I'm not seeing anyone asking to speak. So

wants to speak up, I'm not seeing any phones unmuting. I'm not seeing anyone asking to speak. So going to assume that no one wants to give testimony at this time. And I was just informed that Friday at noon is the other hearing in the gas case, so if someone changes their mind and decides they want to speak, they can log in at that time. There is a different log-in number, but again, you go to the PSC website and get that information.

Okay. Well, thank you all for your participation this evening. And we can go ahead and go off the record.
