Dear Mr. Logan,

The General Services Administration, a federal government agency, on behalf of NGA, will require new ISDN-PRI telephone service from SBC at 3838 Vogel Road in Arnold, Missouri. This service will be required to support a new PBX system that has been ordered by NGA and is planned for installation in early July, 2005. This service will replace Centrex service currently being provided by a CLEC from a foreign serving office. We are requesting that SBC provide a block of 1000 consecutive DID telephone numbers in the 5000 series range, if available, as this will match our current station numbering plan. If the 5 thousand block of numbers is not available, our next preference would be for 1000 number blocks starting with the digit 1, 2, 3, or 6. We would prefer that the 4 & 8 thousands level not be used. It is necessary that the DID numbers be a consecutive block of 1000 numbers due to compatibility with our Defense Switched Network that provides dialing to other Department of Defense sites worldwide. It is our understanding from SBC that there are no available telephone numbers to meet our request for service. SBC is our chosen service provider and we understand that they might escalate to the state utility commission.

It is important that we know whether these numbers will be made available as soon as possible as this impacts the transition to the new telephone system at NGA.
