Response:

Included in the supporting excel file is a tab called 459 Support which shows the current KCP&L forecast for CIP and Cyber spending through 2017 (KCP&L only). This data is divided between CIP and Cyber spending; by company division; by FERC Account (with a brief description of the costs in the FERC account); and into totals for Labor O&M, Non-Labor O&M, and Capital.

The CIP forecast is based on NERC CIP standards which are already subject to enforcement and NERC CIP standards approved and subject to future enforcement. Projected costs are based on project planning for CIP version 5 which is still in process. The Cyber costs are based on current regulatory requirements, but are made with the understanding that Cyber Security is under constant and increasing scrutiny with regulatory rule making advancing from many different sources.

All activities, regardless of whether they are executed by KCP&L employees, contractors working for KCP&L, or 3rd part consulting firms working for the company, will be under the control of KCP&L. KCP&L is responsible for meeting NERC CIP Standards and cannot delegate that responsibility to any other party in the eyes of NERC.
