B. <u>Troy Helming</u>

 - 4. KCPL's projected need is not accurate.
- B. Summary of Troy Helming's opinions:
 - 1. KCPL's plan to build a new coal-fired power plant will cost consumers more than it would if KCPL were to build wind plants.
 - 2. Pollution from the United States' addiction to fossil fuels is ruining our health and our environment. Dependence on
