The accompanying tariff sheets issued by Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE (AmerenUE or the Company), are being transmitted to you for filing as a revision of Schedule No. 2, Schedule of Rates for Gas Service:

These tariff sheets are being issued May 15, 2008 to become effective on and after June 1, 2008.

These revised sheets include changes to Company's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) Clause as approved by the Commission. They reflect adjustments to the Regular Purchased Gas Adjustment (RPGA) factor for the Company's four Missouri service areas.

The changes in the PGA factors applicable to the Company's service areas, excluding the Rolla area, result from an increase in the weighted average cost of gas. The firm sales customers' PGA factors will increase from 89.59¢/Ccf to 110.16¢/Ccf. The interruptible sales customers' PGA factors will increase from 78.71¢/Ccf to 95.23¢/Ccf. The transportation PGA factor will remain unchanged at 0.00¢/Ccf.

The changes in the PGA factors applicable to the Company's Rolla service area (formerly Aquila's Eastern System) result from the combination of changes in the weighted average cost of gas and a change in the calculation methodology of the Missouri Gas Company transportation surcharge. The firm sales customers' PGA factor will decrease from 135.03¢/Ccf to 129.38¢/Ccf. The interruptible sales customers' PGA factor will increase from

91.96¢/Ccf to 96.48¢/Ccf. The transportation PGA factor will remain unchanged at 0.00¢/Ccf.

We are enclosing workpapers supporting this filing with the copy of this filing being provided to the Staff. Certain of the workpapers have been designated "Highly Confidential" since they contain market specific information directly relating to the natural gas markets where AmerenUE must compete for its gas supplies. AmerenUE requests that these workpapers be handled in a manner consistent with this designation.
