## ORDER OF ISSUES, WITNESSES AND CROSS-EXAMINATION

Comes now the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff") and states:

- 1. On February 1, 2006, The Empire District Electric Company filed with the Commission tariff sheets designed to implement a general electric rate increase for service it provides to its Missouri customers. The Commission opened Case No. ER-2006-0315 to address that filing.
- 2. On April 11, 2006, the Commission issued its *Order Concerning Test Year and True-up and Adopting Procedural Schedule* in which it stated, "Each party shall file a list of witnesses to appear on each day of the hearing and the order in which they shall be called," and, "The parties shall establish the order of cross-examination and file a joint pleading indicating the same." The Commission, in ordered paragraph three (3), fixed 4:00 p.m. August 23, 2006, as the time by which the foregoing is to be filed. At the request of counsel for the Staff the presiding officer agreed the time and date by which they may be filed was August 25, 2006 and, after a subsequent request for leave to late file, August 28, 2006.
- 3. The Parties to this proceeding, alphabetically, are: Aquila, Inc., The Empire District Electric Company, Explorer Pipeline, Inc., Kansas City Power & Light Company,

Missouri Department of Natural Resources, the Missouri Public Service Commission Staff, the Office of the Public Counsel, and Praxair, Inc.

4. The Staff solicited and received input from the parties in preparing a proposed hearing schedule. With that input the Staff has assembled the order of witnesses and order of cross-examination set out below. The Staff has attempted to accommodate witness availabilities in this schedule; however, unforeseen eventualities may prompt parties to request changes to the below schedule.

5. Although the proposed schedule anticipates the parties will use less than the full time the Commission has allotted for the evidentiary hearing in September, the proposed schedule commences the hearing on the first day following the Labor Day holiday due to limitations on the availabilities of witnesses and to help ensure the hearing concludes by September 15, 2006.

- 6. Prehearing briefs are due by 4:00 p.m. August 30, 2006.
