On October 1, 2007, The Empire District Electric Company submitted to the Missouri Public Service Commission certain proposed tariff sheets to implement a general rate increase for retail electric service to customers in its Missouri service area. The Commission opened case number ER-2008-0093 to address Empire's electric rate increase request.

On November 16, 2007, the Commission adopted with minor exceptions the procedural schedule jointly proposed by the parties. That procedural schedule, among other things, called for local public hearings to be held on March 12 and 13, 2008. Although the parties did not suggest any specific times or locations for the local public hearings, the Commission's October 16th order advised the parties that the Commission intended to schedule local public hearings in Joplin and Reeds Spring, Missouri, which are

the same locations that were used during Empire's last two rate proceedings.¹ Unfortunately, the requisite facilities are not available in these locations on March 12 and 13, 2008. Accordingly, the Commission shall set public hearings in these locations on March 25 and 26, 2008.

On November 16, 2007, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a proposed customer notice and advised the Commission that no party objects to the proposed notice. The Commission will adopt the public notice recommended by Public Counsel with minor modifications and additions designed to provide additional information to the public.

For the first hearing, the Staff of the Commission will hold an informal question and answer session on March 25, 2008, beginning at 5:30 p.m., the hearing will begin at 6:00 p.m., and will conclude at approximately 9:00 p.m., or earlier if all persons present who wish to testify have done so. For the second hearing, the Staff of the Commission will hold an informal question and answer session on March 26, 2008, beginning at 11:30 a.m., the hearing will begin at 12:00 p.m., and will conclude at approximately 3:00 p.m., or earlier if all persons present who wish to testify have done so. For the third hearing, the Staff of the Commission will hold an informal question and answer session on March 26, 2008, beginning at 11:30 a.m., the hearing will begin at 12:00 p.m., and will conclude at approximately 3:00 p.m., or earlier if all persons present who wish to testify have done so. For the third hearing, the Staff of the Commission will hold an informal question and answer session on March 26, 2008, beginning at 5:30 p.m., the hearing will begin at 6:00 p.m., and will conclude at approximately 9:00 p.m., or earlier if all persons present who wish to testify have done so.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Commission shall hold a local public hearing on March 25, 2008, from 6:00 p.m. until approximately 9:00 p.m., or until all persons who wish to testify have done so, whichever is sooner, and shall also hold a local public hearing on March 26, 2008, from 12:00 p.m. until approximately 3:00 p.m., or until all persons who wish to testify have done

so, whichever is sooner, at the Missouri Southern State University, Webster Hall, 3950 East Newman Road, Joplin, Missouri.

2. The Commission shall hold a local public hearing on March 26, 2008, from 6:00 p.m. until approximately 9:00 p.m., or until all persons who wish to testify have done so, whichever is sooner, at the Tri-Lakes TCRC, University of Missouri Extension at Reeds Spring High School, ITV Room, 20277 State Highway 413 (in the South Wing of Reeds Spring High School), Reeds Spring, Missouri.

3. No later than ten days prior to the local public hearings, The Empire District

Electric Company shall provide individual notice to each of its electric service customers

including all or the relevant portions of the notice as set out below.

NOTICE

On October 1, 2007, The Empire District Electric Company filed revised electric service tariff sheets with the Missouri Public Service Commission (PSC) which would increase the Company's Missouri jurisdictional annual gross revenues by approximately 10.1 percent. For a residential customer using approximately 1,000 kilowatt-hours of electricity a month, the proposed increase would be approximately \$9.75 each month.

Local public hearings have been set before the PSC as follows:

 At 6:00 p.m., Tuesday, March 25, 2008, at Webster Hall, Missouri Southern State University, 3950 E. Newman Road, Joplin, Missouri.

 At 12:00 p.m., Wednesday, March 26, 2008, at Webster Hall, Missouri Southern State University, 3950 E. Newman Road, Joplin, Missouri.

 At 6:00 p.m. Wednesday, March 26, 2008, at the Tri-Lakes TCRC, University of Missouri Extension at Reeds Spring High School, ITV Room, 20277 State Highway 413 (in the South Wing of Reeds Spring High School), Reeds Spring, Missouri.

*A question-and-answer session will be held one-half hour before the beginning of each hearing.

5. The Data Center of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall serve a

6. The Public Information Office of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall send a copy of this order to members of the General Assembly and to the media that serve The Empire District Electric Company's service area.

7. The Empire District Electric Company shall place advertisements in the newspapers serving its service territory. The advertisements shall contain the information from the customer notice relevant to the customers in the newspaper's circulation area.
