ORDER ADMITTING TESTIMONY AND CANCELING TRUE-UP HEARING

A hearing regarding true-up issues is currently scheduled for January 6 and 7, 2009. In compliance with the previously established procedural schedule, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE filed the true-up direct testimony of Gary Weiss on December 22, 2008. On that same date, the Commission's Staff filed a statement indicating that it is not aware of any issues that the Commission would need to consider at a true-up hearing. No other party filed true-up direct testimony and no party filed true-up rebuttal testimony by the December 30 deadline established in the procedural schedule.

On December 31, the Commission issued an order indicating that if no party requested a true-up hearing or objected to the admission of Weiss' true-up testimony by noon on January 2, 2009, the Commission would cancel that hearing and admit the true-up testimony into evidence. That deadline has now passed and no party has filed either a request for a true-up hearing or objections to admission of the true-up testimony.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The True-Up Direct Testimony of Gary S. Weiss, filed by Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, is admitted into evidence as Exhibit No. 081.

2. The true-up hearing scheduled for January 6 and 7, 2009, is cancelled.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
