DST Realty, Inc, together with its ownership through Downtown Investors, is the owner of the below listed office buildings in downtown Kansas City, Missouri, all of which are presently served by Kansas City Power & Light central steam generation:

A review of the possible methods of conversion to alternate steam sources for these properties indicates that the most feasible alternative is electric steam boiler conversions. Due to the magnitude of this required change and the fact the electrical installation is more feasible due to installation and ventilation and flueing considerations required for a gas conversion, a program for electrical conversion would be very urgently needed.
