ORDER DIRECTING FILINGS

On October 16, 2007, Missouri Gas Utility, Inc., filed a Motion for Leave to Amend Application. In its motion, MGU asked that it be allowed to substitute Appendix A of its application for an updated Appendix A showing a different location of the proposed line. MGU did not state whether the changed location would alter its other attachments to the application, such as the construction cost estimate¹ or the names and addresses of land-owners affected.² Thus, the Commission shall direct MGU to clarify its motion by either updating its other appendices or stating that no changes to those appendices are required.

Also on October 16, 2007, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed its Staff Status Report in which it states that it expects to be able to make its recommendation no later than October 30, 2007. Therefore, the Commission shall set that date for the filing of Staff's recommendation.
