On January 12, 2021,¹ Spire Missouri Inc. (Spire) filed an Application For Certificate of Convenience and Necessity for Barry County and Request for Waiver (Application) with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) requesting permission and approval for a certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) to construct, install, own, operate, maintain, and otherwise control and manage a natural gas distribution system to provide gas service in Barry County, Missouri, as a further expansion of its existing certificated area. On April 19, the Commission’s Staff filed its Recommendation, and on April 28, Spire filed its Response. The Commission will schedule a procedural conference. Because of the continuing COVID19 pandemic, the conference will be conducted via Webex.
