MOTION/REQUEST FOR SUBPOENA DUCES TECUM

COMES NOW Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union Company ("MGE"), and, in accordance with Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") Rule 4 CSR 240-2.100, moves/requests the Commission to issue the subpoena *duces tecum* described herein:

1. On May 6, 2004, the Commission issued its Order Setting Hearing, which, among other things, set this matter for hearing on July 19, 2004.

2. MGE seeks to take the deposition of Ms. Robin Miller of Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCPL") prior to the hearing of this case.
