ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR REHEARING

On October 16, 2013, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued a Report and Order effective October 30, 2013, regarding Liberty Energy (Midstates) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Utilities' application for approval to change its infrastructure system replacement surcharge. On October 25, 2013, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a timely application for rehearing.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo 2000, indicates the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." In the judgment of the Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel has not shown sufficient reason to rehear the order. The Commission will deny the application for rehearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Office of the Public Counsel's Application for Rehearing is denied.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
