ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO SUSPEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On July 18, 2007, the Commission issued an order scheduling a prehearing conference and setting August 7, 2007, as the date by which the parties were to file a proposed procedural schedule if the dispute was not resolved. Just prior to the date of the prehearing, Laclede Gas Company informed the parties and the Commission that it and Ms. Kalemis had resolved their dispute. The Commission suspended the prehearing conference pending completion of the settlement and Ms. Kalemis's dismissal of the case.

On August 8, 2007, Laclede filed a Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule. Laclede stated that the parties have not yet finished the paperwork necessary to complete the settlement and dismiss the case. Laclede requested that the filing of a procedural schedule be postponed until August 21, 2007, to allow the parties to finalize the resolution of the dispute.

Having reviewed the motion, the Commission finds that it is reasonable to postpone the filing date as requested by Laclede.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Laclede Gas Company's Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule is granted.
- 2. If the parties do not resolve their dispute, Laclede Gas Company shall prepare and file a jointly proposed procedural schedule no later than August 21, 2007.
 - 3. This order shall become effective on August 9, 2007.
