This case has been delayed while Staff worked on tariff issues of a similar nature with Laclede Gas Company in Case No. GT-2009-0056. The parties in the Laclede case continue their efforts to fashion liability-limiting language.

On February 5, 2009, Staff filed a status report in this case. Because Staff of the Gas Safety/Engineering and Tariffs/Rate Design Departments are working on tariff language that could conceivably be proposed or considered in this case, Staff requests additional time before suggesting a procedural schedule. Staff proposes to file a status report near the end of March 2009, and requests the Commission to extend the time to file a proposed procedural schedule until March 30, 2009.

The Commission has considered Staff's status report and finds it reasonable to grant a further extension of time.
