



cause for approval of tariff JG-2010-0027 on less than thirty days notice is demonstrated by Atmos' Commission-approved PGA clause allowing for ten business days notice for PGA change filings and its Motion. Staff has no objection to Atmos' request because the Neelyville District's minimal ACA balance at the end of July, 2009 will avoid an over-collection of gas costs. For reasons further explained in Staff's Memorandum, attached as Appendix A and incorporated by reference, the Staff recommends the Motion be granted and the tariff sheet filed on July 16, 2009, be allowed to become effective on August 1, 2009.

WHEREFORE, for the above stated reasons, the Staff recommends the Commission grant Atmos' Motion and approve tariff JG-2010-0027 as filed on July 16, 2009, allowing the tariff to become effective on August 1, 2009.
