Hi Warren,
Hi Bob,

Carmen and I just had a short conference call with David Ries of Missouri Interstate Gas. The purpose of our call was to discuss the dropping of MIG's application docket and tariff docket from FERC's agenda today. We found that none of know, but suspect that it was simply dropped because the agenda was too lengthy. During the discussion, we learned that MIG's facilities are completed and ready for service. Plans are to purge the line, fill it with gas, and conduct testing. Mr. Ries anticipates all of this will be completed sometime early next week. Mr. Ries also stated that MRT does not yet have its metering station ready. Mr. Ries did acknowledge that, although the facilities are nearly all ready, he can not begin to sell capacity until he has tariffs approved by FERC.

As our conversation began to wind down, Mr. Ries asked about the status of possibly "bundling" his sales. Carmen mentioned to him that issue wasn't within our bailiwick. I suspect he will be touching base with you soon regarding this issue, Warren.
