**APPLICATION TO INTERVENE
OF THE MISSOURI INDUSTRIAL ENERGY CONSUMERS**

Comes now Anheuser-Busch, The Boeing Company, Enbridge, General Motors, Hussmann Refrigeration, Mallinkrodt, MEMC Electronic Materials, Monsanto, and Nestlé Purina, hereafter referred to as the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (“MIEC”) and pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.075, and the Commission’s January 15, 2013 *Order Suspending Tariff, Directing Notice and Setting Intervention Date*, files its Application to Intervene. In support of its Application, the MIEC states as follows:

1. The MIEC is a group of large customers of Laclede Gas Company (“Laclede”), and the rates, terms and conditions of the MIEC’s natural gas service will be affected by the outcome of this case.
2. The MIEC’s interest in this case is to ensure just and reasonable natural gas rates and reliable natural gas service.
3. As a group of large industrial customers of Laclede, the MIEC’s interest in this proceeding is different than that of the general public;
4. The MIEC does not yet have sufficient information to take a position regarding Laclede’s application in this case, but reserves the right to take positions on all issues that may affect its members in this case.

WHEREFORE, the MIEC requests that the Commission grant its Application to Intervene herein and make it a party to this case for all purposes.
