On January 17, 2014¹, Laclede filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission under Sections 393.1009, 393.1012 and 393.1015, RSMo Cum. Supp. 2012, requesting that the Commission authorize the company to establish an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge for numerous gas utility plant projects. The Commission issued notice of the application on January 21, giving potential intervenors until February 10 to request intervention. The Commission received no intervention requests.

On February 6, Laclede filed a Request for Approval of Customer Notices. Laclede did so pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.265(8), (9).

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(13) allows parties ten days to respond to pleadings unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. The Commission issued no order to the contrary, ten days have elapsed since Laclede's request, and no party has objected thereto. Thus, the Commission will take up Laclede's request unopposed.

The Commission finds Laclede's request reasonable, and will grant it.
