ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF

On August 8, 2012¹, Liberty Energy (Midstates) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Utilities filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission under Sections 393.1009, 393.1012 and 393.1015, RSMo Cum. Supp. 2007, requesting that the Commission authorize the company to establish an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge for numerous gas utility plant projects. Section 393.1015.2(3) requires the Commission to act on the application no later than 120 days after it was filed. That means the Commission must issue an order regarding the application effective no later than December 6.

Along with its application, Liberty filed a tariff that will implement the surcharge.

Unless the Commission suspends that tariff, it will become effective on September 7.

So that it can consider Liberty's implementing tariff and the underlying application, that tariff shall be suspended until December 6, unless sooner approved by the Commission.
