On January 17, 2014¹, Laclede filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission under Sections 393.1009, 393.1012 and 393.1015, RSMo Cum. Supp. 2012, requesting that the Commission authorize the company to establish an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge for numerous gas utility plant projects. The Commission issued notice of the application on January 21, giving potential intervenors until February 10 to request intervention. The Commission received no intervention requests.

On March 27, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a Motion for Evidentiary Hearing. OPC contends that some of the expenses Laclede wishes to recover in an ISRS are not allowed under Missouri law.

The Commission must now determine how to proceed to consider Laclede's application and petition. To assist in that determination, the Commission will schedule a procedural conference.
