**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF FILING IN COMPLIANCE
WITH COMMISSION ORDER**

Issue Date: October 10, 2013

Effective Date: October 18, 2013

On October 3, 2013, the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) issued an *Order Approving Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge, but Rejecting Tariff*. The order authorized Ameren Missouri to file a new tariff to recover revenues related to the approved infrastructure system replacement surcharge. Ameren Missouri filed a revised tariff sheet on October 3, 2013 bearing an effective date of November 2, 2013, and requested approval of the revised tariff on less than thirty days’ notice. The Commission set a response deadline, and on October 9, 2013, the Commission’s Staff filed a recommendation for the Commission to approve the tariff filing on less than thirty days’ notice. No other party responded or opposed approval of the tariff.

Section 393.140(11), RSMo 2000, provides that the Commission may permit a tariff to take effect on less than thirty days’ notice upon a showing of good cause. The Commission concludes that good cause exists for expedited approval because no party has objected and October 18, 2013 is the earliest date that Ameren Missouri’s billing system can implement the new rate. The Commission has reviewed the tariff filing and

Staff's verified recommendation, and the Commission will approve the tariff sheet to take effect on October 18, 2013.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The tariff sheet filed on October 3, 2013 by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, Tariff Tracking Number YG-2014-0161, bearing the effective date of November 2, 2013, is approved to become effective on October 18, 2013.
2. This order shall become effective on October 18, 2013.
3. This file shall be closed on October 19, 2013.
