## ORDER SCHEDULING A DISCOVERY CONFERENCE AS REQUESTED BY OFFICE OF THE PUBLIC COUNSEL

On March 7, 2007, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a motion requesting that the Commission schedule an expedited informal discovery conference so that Public Counsel could seek resolution of its disagreements with AmerenUE regarding certain pending data requests. But, since Public Counsel has requested a conference by filing a motion, the Commission will issue an order to schedule that conference.
