ORDER SETTING DATE FOR ON-THE-RECORD PRESENTATION OF STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT

On April 9, 2007, the Commission issued notice that it would schedule an on-the-record presentation in Aquila, Inc., d/b/a Aquila Networks–MPS and Aquila Networks–L&P's electric rate case – Case No. ER-2007-0004 – for the purpose of considering the stipulation and agreement that has been filed in this case. That notice further stated that on-the-record presentation would be at 9:00 a.m. on either Wednesday, April 11th or Thursday, April 12th, depending upon how the evidentiary hearing progressed.

The Commission finds that it is necessary and in the public interest to set this presentation on less than ten days notice because of the quickly approaching operation of law date. Should the Commission determine not to accept the stipulation and agreement there will need to be sufficient time remaining to hear the outstanding issues. Due to witness availability it is no longer feasible to hold the presentation on April 11th. Accordingly, the on-the-record presentation will be held on Thursday, April 12, 2007, at 9:00 a.m.

The Commission has established a conference call bridge number to which attorneys and witnesses may call if they wish to participate in the on-the-record presentation by phone. That number is 573-522-8022. That number will be activated at the start of the hearing on April 12th.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Commission will hold an on-the-record presentation regarding the stipulation and agreement beginning at 9:00 a.m. on April 12, 2007.

2. The presentation shall be held in Room 310 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. The Governor Office Building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
