ORDER GRANTING PUBLIC COUNSEL'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE TESTIMONY

The procedural schedule for this case requires the parties, other than AmerenUE, to file direct testimony on revenue requirement issues on August 28, 2008. On August 27, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a motion indicating that Ryan Kind planned to file direct testimony, but that he has suffered a death in his family and consequently has been unable to complete his testimony. Public Counsel asks for a one-week extension to allow Mr. Kind until September 4 to file his testimony. Public Counsel represents that AmerenUE does not object to the requested extension.

Under the circumstances, the Commission will grant Public Counsel's request and extend the filing date for Mr. Kind to file his direct testimony. Direct testimony on revenue requirement issues from other witnesses will remain due on August 28.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- Public Counsel's Request for Extension of Time is granted.
- 2. Public Counsel may file Ryan Kind's direct testimony on revenue requirement issues no later than September 4, 2008.
