ORDER SETTING ORAL ARGUMENT

On March 2, 2009, Kansas City Power and Light Company (“KCPL”) and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (“GMO”) (collectively the “Companies”), filed a status report and a motion to extend the True-Up period. The Commission granted the request to extend the True-Up proceeding on March 18, but also imposed certain conditions recommended by its Staff. On March 19, the Companies filed a motion requesting the Commission reconsider the imposition of the conditions. Responsive pleadings were filed by the Commission’s Staff, the Office of the Public Counsel and the Industrial Intervenors.¹

To aid the Commission with its decision on how to structure the True-Up proceedings, and fully consider the implications of its determination, the Commission shall schedule oral arguments.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. That the Commission will hear oral arguments regarding the True-Up proceedings on April 6, 2009, beginning at 11:00 a.m., or upon the adjournment of the oral arguments set in Case No. ER-2009-0089, whichever is later.

2. The hearing will be held in Room 310 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This proceeding will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
