## ORDER SETTING PUBLIC COMMENT HEARINGS

Issue Date: January 6, 2009 Effective Date: January 6, 2009

On September 5, 2008, Kansas City Power & Light Company submitted to the Commission proposed tariff sheets intended to implement a general rate increase for electrical service provided in its Missouri service area. The Commission published notice of the filing and set procedural dates, among them a date for the Office of the Public Counsel to submit proposed language for the company's notification to customers of public comment hearings. Public Counsel filed a proposed customer notice on October 22, 2008. No party has objected to Public Counsel's draft notice. The notice is generally acceptable; however, the Commission will make minor modifications.

On December 4, 2008, the Commission directed the parties to file recommendations regarding the times, dates, and locations for local public hearings. On December 15, 2008, Public Counsel, on behalf of the parties, filed a joint recommendation that the Commission hold public comment hearings at the following locations: Marshall, Carrollton, and Kansas City, Missouri.

The Commission is in the process of scheduling the public comment hearings, but has been delayed by the fact that the preferred sites in several of the locations are

academic institutions, which have been on their holiday break. The hearings in Carrollton and Marshall, however, have been set, and the Commission will issue notice of these comment hearings so that KCPL can notify its customers in those areas. The Commission will issue a subsequent order when the remaining comment hearings have been scheduled.

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Commission shall hold a public comment hearing on Thursday, February 19, 2009, beginning at 6:00 p.m. and continuing until all persons who wish to testify have done so, in the Videoconference Center of the Carrollton Public Library, 1 North Folger, Carrollton, Missouri. This hearing will be conducted by videoconference from the Commission's hearing room in Jefferson City, Missouri.
- 2. The Commission shall hold a public comment hearing on Thursday, March 5, 2009, beginning at 6:00 p.m. and continuing until all persons who wish to testify have done so, in Room 2 (the ITV room) of the Saline County Career Center, 900 West Vest, Marshall, Missouri. This hearing will be conducted by videoconference from the Commission's hearing room in Jefferson City, Missouri.
- 3. No later than ten days prior to the public comment hearing, Kansas City Power & Light Company shall provide an individual notice to each of its customers in the Carrollton and Marshall, Missouri areas as set out below.

#### **IMPORTANT NOTICE**

Kansas City Power & Light Company has filed revised electric service tariff sheets with the Missouri Public Service Commission that would increase the company's Missouri jurisdictional annual gross revenues by \$102 million or approximately 17.5%. For the average residential customer, the increase would be approximately \$14 per month.

The PSC will conduct local public comment hearings to solicit input from the company's customers, as follows:

- Thursday, February 19, 2009, beginning at 6:00 p.m., in the Videoconference Center of the Carrollton Public Library, 1 North Folger, Carrollton, Missouri. The hearing will be conducted by videoconference from the Commission's hearing room in Jefferson City, Missouri.
- Thursday, March 5, 2009, beginning at 6:00 p.m., in Room 2 (the ITV room) of the Saline County Career Center, 900 West Vest, Marshall, Missouri. The hearing will be conducted by video-conference from the Commission's hearing room in Jefferson City, Missouri.

### A question-and-answer session will be held one-half hour before the beginning of the hearing.

The PSC will also conduct evidentiary hearings at the PSC offices, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri, April 20 – 24, and April 27 – May 1, 2009, beginning at 9:00 A.M.
