ORDER DISMISSING APPLICATION

Issue Date: October 19, 2017

Effective Date: October 29, 2017

On June 15, 2017, EDF Energy Services, LLC filed an *Application for Certification as a Seller of Energy Services in the State of Missouri*. On October 2, 2017, Staff filed a recommendation advising the Commission to dismiss the application because EDF does not need to be certified as a seller of energy services¹.

EDF seeks certification under 393.299, RSMo, which requires persons (except distributors or a political subdivision itself) who provide energy services in any county, municipality, or village in Missouri to apply to the Commission for certification as an energy seller.

In its recommendation, Staff states the only energy services EDF intends to provide in Missouri would consist of “upstream” natural gas transactions, where title to the natural gas transfers at the Local Gas Distribution Company’s city gate. Staff explains the statute applies only to energy sellers who transfer title to gas “downstream” of a Local Gas Distribution Company’s city gate. Therefore, Staff concludes EDF does not need to be certified as an energy seller under the statute.

¹ Section 393.298(4),(10), RSMo 2016, defines “energy services” and “seller” as used in section 393.299, RSMo 2016.

No other party has responded to Staff's recommendation and the Commission finds that recommendation persuasive. On the basis of Staff's recommendation, the Commission concludes that EDF does not need to be certified as an energy seller. For that reason, the Commission will dismiss EDF's application.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. EDF Energy Services, LLC's Application for Certification as a Seller of Energy Services in the State of Missouri is dismissed.
2. This order shall become effective on October 29, 2017.
3. This file shall be closed on October 30, 2017.
