Certificate Of Convenience And Necessity

DATE: October 25, 2007

On September 11, 2007, Missouri Gas Utility, Inc. (MGU or Company) filed an <u>APPLICATION</u> (Application) with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission). The Application requests that the Commission grant MGU a certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) authorizing it to construct, install, own, operate, control, manage and maintain a natural gas distribution system to provide gas service in Harrison County, Missouri, as a further expansion of its existing certified area. On September 14, 2007, the Commission issued an <u>ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING DATE FOR SUBMISSION OF INTERVENTION REQUESTS</u> (Order), which allows any interveners to file by October 4, 2007. On October 16, 2007, MGU filed its <u>MOTION FOR LEAVE TO AMEND APPLICATION</u>, which included an Amended Appendix A. On October 23, 2007, Staff filed its recommendation recommending approval of the CCN. On October 24, 2007, MGU filed its <u>MGU's RESPONSE TO ORDER DIRECTING FILING AND MOTION FOR LEAVE TO AMEND</u> (Response), which included an Amended Appendix B.

This Amended Recommendation is being filed because Staff inadvertently did not address item 1 of the Commission's Order requiring MGU to supplement its Application. MGU had requested Staff's recommendation expeditiously, so that the potential customers could be served before the winter season.

MGU is requesting a CCN adjacent to MGU's presently certified service area in Harrison County, to provide service to Maschhoffs, Inc. (Maschhoffs). MGU plans to extend service to Maschhoffs pursuant to its service extension policy detailed in its Commission approved tariff. Approximately eighty percent (80%) the proposed extension would utilize private rights of way. There is no opposition to the project.

MGU filed its feasibility study (study) along with its Application. The total estimated cost of the project was \$125,000 in Appendix B of the Application, and it was revised to \$116,501 in the Amended Appendix B in MGU's Response. After the initial construction, the study projects the annual revenues will exceed the annual costs over the next three (3) years. MGU states that additional customers may be served off the extension subject to MGU's line extension policy in its tariff.

The Staff has reviewed this Application and for the following reasons is of the opinion that granting this Application would be in the public interest:

- 1. MGU is willing and able to provide the requested service under existing tariff provisions,
- 2. Extending gas service would not jeopardize natural gas service to the Company's currently existing customers,
- 3. No interveners have objected to this certificate request, and
- 4. No new franchises are required.

Therefore, Staff recommends that MGU be granted a certificate to serve the requested area in Harrison County, Missouri. Staff also recommends the Company file revised tariff sheets reflecting this proposed CCN in this case within thirty (30) days of the Commission's Order approving this Application.

The Staff has verified that this company has filed its annual report and is not delinquent on any assessment.
