ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
FIRST AMENDED COMPLAINT

On November 6, 2007, the Commission ordered Norman Harrold to file a first amended complaint by no later than December 6, 2007. On December 6, Mr. Harrold filed a pleading in which he requested that the Commission grant him an additional two weeks to prepare his first amended complaint.

Mr. Harrold's request for a two-week extension of time to file his first amended complaint, which is authorized under the terms of Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.050(3)(A), will be granted.¹ However, since this matter has already been pending for nearly ten months, he is further advised that no further extensions will be granted absent the consent of all the other parties or a showing of extraordinary circumstances.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

¹ Mr. Harrold's December 6 pleading also contains two other requests, which relate to discovery and Laclede's delivery of disconnect notices to his home. These requests will not be addressed in this order, as they are either premature or moot.

1. Norman Harrold's request for a two-week extension of time to file his first amended complaint is granted. That pleading is now due no later than December 20, 2007.

2. This order shall become effective on December 11, 2007.
