ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO INVESTIGATE AND FILE A REPORT AND DIRECTING OTHER FILING

Irene Dsouza filed a formal complaint against Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE ("AmerenUE") on May 21, 2007. On May 24, 2007, the Commission notified AmerenUE of the complaint and allowed it thirty days in which to answer as provided by 4 CSR 240-2.070(7).

The Commission would like to have the benefit of an investigation and report by its Staff before it further considers this matter.¹ Given the circumstances described in the complaint, Staff should be able to complete its investigation and prepare a report concerning the results of that investigation no later than three weeks after AmerenUE files its answer, which is due no later than June 25, 2007.

¹ AmerenUE's answer period has just begun. However, 4 CSR 240-2.070(10) states that "[t]he commission may order, at any time after the filing of a complaint, an investigation by its staff as to the cause of the complaint."

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall promptly commence an investigation of Irene Dsouza's formal complaint against Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE.
- 2. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a report concerning the results of its investigation no later than three weeks after AmerenUE files its answer to Ms. Dsouza's complaint.
 - 3. This order shall become effective on May 24, 2007.
