**NOTICE ACKNOWLEDGING DISMISSAL OF COMPLAINT
AND CLOSING CASE**

Issue Date: September 24, 2007

On July 10, 2007, C. K. Lacks, L.L.C., filed a complaint with the Commission against Laclede Gas Company. On August 13, Laclede filed its answer to the complaint and on August 23, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed the report of its investigation into this matter.

On September 21, 2007, prior to the filing of any testimony or the admission of any evidence, Complainant filed a voluntary Notice of Dismissal stating that it and Laclede have reached a resolution regarding the complaint. Complainant also states that all parties of record had been served with a copy of the notice.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) permits a complainant to voluntarily dismiss its complaint without an order of the Commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered by filing a notice of dismissal and serving a copy on all parties. No prepared testimony or oral evidence has been offered in this

case, and Complainant represents that all parties have been served with its notice. Therefore, the Commission acknowledges that C. K. Lacks, L.L.C. has voluntarily dismissed its complaint. Nothing remains for decision by the Commission and this case may be closed.
