ORDER SETTING COMPLAINT FOR HEARING

On November 21, 2007, Renee Anderson filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Laclede Gas Company. Laclede filed its answer to the complaint on December 20, 2007, and the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed its Report on January 18, 2008.

By order dated January 22, 2008, the Commission set the case for a prehearing conference, which was held on February 11, 2008. In the same order, the parties were directed to jointly prepare and file a proposed procedural schedule by no later than February 19.

Staff filed a Proposed Procedural Schedule on behalf of the parties. The proposed procedural schedule omitted any date for prefiled testimony.

The Commission has reviewed the proposed procedural schedule and agrees that there is no need for prefiled testimony in this case. The Commission will set this matter for

evidentiary hearing on May 9, 2008. The Commission will set forth the procedure it will follow to hear Ms. Anderson's case.

All testimony will be presented live and in person. Ms. Anderson will testify first and present her case to the Commission. She will then be subject to cross-examination (questions), first by the Staff of the Commission, then by the Office of the Public Counsel, and finally by Laclede Gas Company.

Laclede will then present its witness[es] who will be subject to cross-examination by first by Staff, then by Public Counsel, and finally by Ms. Anderson.

The Staff of the Commission will present its witness[es] next, with cross-examination first by Laclede, then by Public Counsel, and finally by Ms. Anderson.

All parties are directed to bring twelve (12) copies of any document they intend to present at the hearing. Ms. Anderson is advised that failure to participate in the evidentiary hearing could result in her case being dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. This matter is set for hearing on May 9, 2008, beginning at 10:00 a.m. The hearing will be held in Room 310 in the offices of the Missouri Public Service Commission, Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. The hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. 2. The parties shall prepare and file an issues list with position statements on or before May 2, 2008.

3. Renee Anderson shall be prepared to present her case as set forth above.
4. This order shall become effective on February 20, 2008.
