NOTICE ACKNOWLEDGING VOLUNTARY DISMISSAL OF COMPLAINT
AND CLOSING CASE

Issue Date: March 10, 2008

Daniel J. Sebelski filed a formal complaint against Laclede Gas Company ("Laclede") on January 18, 2008.¹ On January 24, the Commission notified Laclede of the complaint and allowed it thirty days in which to answer as provided by 4 CSR 240-2.070(7). The same day, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.070(10), the Commission ordered its Staff to commence an investigation of Mr. Sebelski's formal complaint and to file a report concerning the results of its investigation no later than one week after Laclede filed its answer to the complaint.

Laclede timely filed its answer to Mr. Sebelski's complaint on February 25. Thus, the due date for Staff's report and recommendation was March 3. On February 27, Staff filed its Request for Extension of Time to File Staff's Report of Investigation (in which it proposed

to file its report and recommendation by March 17 if the case had not yet settled), which was granted by Commission order dated February 28.

On March 7, prior to the filing of any prepared testimony or the submission of any oral evidence, Mr. Sebelski filed a Notice of Dismissal ("Notice"), in which he informed the Commission that he had resolved all disputes with Laclede covered by the complaint and that all parties of record had been served with a copy of the Notice.

Accordingly, Mr. Sebelski requests that the Commission acknowledge the Notice and close the case pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.116(1), which permits a complainant to voluntarily dismiss his complaint without an order of the Commission "at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered, by filing a notice of dismissal with the commission and serving a copy on all parties."

No prepared testimony or oral evidence has been offered in this case, and the Notice has been filed with the Commission and served on all parties. Therefore, the Commission acknowledges that Daniel J. Sebelski has voluntarily dismissed his complaint against Laclede Gas Company. Nothing remains for decision by the Commission and this case may be closed.
