ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On August 8, 2008, Tonya Davis filed a complaint against Laclede Gas Company. The Commission issued notice of the complaint, directing Laclede to respond and the Staff of the Commission to investigate the matter and file a report. On September 29, 2008, Staff filed a motion requesting an extension of time. Staff states that Respondent's counsel has informed Staff that Laclede has concluded a tentative settlement of the case with Ms. Davis. Staff requests the Commission to extend the time for filing its report to October 7, 2008, to allow sufficient time for the parties to formalize their settlement.

The Commission has considered Staff's motion and finds it reasonable to grant the requested extension of time.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff's Motion for Extension of Time is granted.

2. Staff shall file the report of its investigation no later than October 7, 2008.
3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
