ORDER SCHEDULING A PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On November 13, 2007, Isabelle Condict filed a complaint against Laclede Gas Company alleging that Laclede overestimated the amount of gas she used during a period when Laclede's meter at her home was not functioning. In December, the parties agreed that Laclede would collect information about Condict's use of gas during the 2007-2008 winter season and use that information to possibly negotiate a settlement of the complaint.

Laclede filed a status report on April 30, 2008, in which it offered to resolve the complaint by applying a credit of 214 CCF of gas to Ms. Condict's account for the disputed period, based on the reduced usage shown during the past winter. The Commission ordered Ms. Condict to respond to Laclede's settlement offer by May 19, but she has not done so.

In order to move this complaint to a prompt resolution, the Commission will schedule a prehearing conference to discuss a procedural schedule.
